Owner: Eric Johnson reached out to Mike and Jim Ring to build him a car. They wanted the challenge of building a European muscle car. The Ringbrothers build time of 8,200 hours. Octavia was born and debuted in August of 2025 at The Quail show in Carmel California for Monterey Car Week and turned heads at SEMA!!

Engine & Transmission: Wegner Motorsports 5.0-liter Coyote V8 with custom 2.65-liter Harrop supercharger (tuned to 805 horsepower; tested to 1,016 horsepower) with a Bowler TREMEC TR-6060 Magnum six-speed manual transaxle and torque tube. Strange Engineering Ford 9-inch rear end with S/S 31-spline axles.

Exhaust: Custom built Ringbrothers headers, insulated with HeaderShield, custom built exhaust by Ringbrothers with Borla mufflers featuring carbon fiber and stainless steel. Chassis: Custom Roadster Shop FAST TRACK Stage II chassis, Roadster Shop suspension, Fox Facing fixed valve coil over shocks with 1.25-inch splined front sway bar with C7 Corvette end links

Wheels & Tires: One-off three-piece HRE wheels with center lock and Porsche pin drive hubs, 19x11 front wheels and 20x13 rear wheels on Michelin Pilot Sport Cup 2 tires

Exterior: BASF Glasurit Double-0 Silver paint with Nuclear Olive trim, full carbon fiber body by Gemini Technology Systems, Inc., machined front and rear bumpers, one-off Gentex custom taillights, one-off carbon fiber grille

Interior: Dakota digital gauges, Gentex custom full display mirror, rearview auto dimming mirror and cameras, one-off auto dimming side view mirrors with electronic controls, Ringbrothers Octavia steering wheel, Vintage air climate control system and installation performed by Steve Pearson at Upholstery Unlimited

Major Modifications: Widened rear end 10 inches, front end 8 inches, wheelbase extended forward 3 inches, one-off custom engineered structural cage, Fully bespoke carbon fiber bodywork, one-off carbon fiber clamshell hood, custom widescreen, windows and rear glass, 3D printed stainless badging and custom interior switchgear, carbon fiber front air dam, airbox and intake... and much much more!!!!
